The Holy Spirit is a Person

The Holy Spirit is the 3rd Person of the Trinity

God's power and presence dwell in us in the person of the Holy Spirit

We are not our own – and we are not on our own

Acts 1:8

⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Pentecost: *Day of Firstfruits*

Genesis 2:7 (KJV)

⁷ And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

The Holy Spirit is the *breath of God*

Ruach Elohim - Spirit of God

The Hebrew word interpreted as *spirit* is *ruach*, meaning "air in motion." It is the same word we get "breath" from. It can also mean "life."

When the Spirit breathes, *dead things come to life*

When the Spirit breathes, there is no *doubt*
