Does hope seem like it is something for others, but not you?

Proverbs 13:12

¹² Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a longing fulfilled is a tree of life.

God wants to give us hope - Satan wants to steal our hope.

What if our lack of hope is an inside job?

Psalm 27:1-3

¹ The LORD is my light and my salvation—
whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life—
of whom shall I be afraid?
² When the wicked advance against me
to devour me,
it is my enemies and my foes
who will stumble and fall.
³ Though an army besiege me,
my heart will not fear;
though war break out against me,
even then I will be confident.

There are times when this overwhelming war breaking out against us is fear itself.

Before fear can take root in our hearts, it has to conquer our minds.

Lord, I commit today to not let fear conquer my mind.

Satan wants you to not only experience fear, but give in to it.

Fear is fueled by imagination.

Anxiety is a mindset of fear that has moved in.

Anxiety is a mindset that involves expectation of that negative outcome we are fearing.

Anxiety is fear left unattended.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5

³ For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. ⁴ The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. ⁵ We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

Fear is an argument happening in your head.

We need to stop fighting fear on our own and instead, take it to see our Commander in Chief!

We must stop lashing out, and start crying out!

Romans 8:15

¹⁵ The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."
