Second-guessing robs us of joy, hope, and peace.

What would life look like without second guessing?

Second guessing is caused by a lack of self-confidence.

“Second-guessing is often caused by not trusting ourselves. Self-doubt can happen as a result of critical parents, perfectionist tendencies, low self-confidence or pessimistic thinking.”

We do not have the ability to self-correct.

We can only change our behavior. We can't change who we are.

Our only hope in healing from insecurity and second-guessing is God's truth.

God's truth is infallible and immutable.

There is no such thing as progressive Christianity.

God never said His truth would always be popular!

The Lord's word is flawless;

he shields all who take refuge in him.

1 John 3:19-21 Message Version:

It's also the way to shut down debilitating self-criticism, even when there is something to it. For God is greater than our worried hearts and knows more about us than we do ourselves. And friends, once that's taken care of and we're no longer accusing or condemning ourselves, we're bold and free before God!

God's truth sets me free!

John 8:32

32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

Truth itself won't do anything until we know it.

We cannot know God's truth without spending time in His Word and in prayer.

Truth does not set us free by osmosis.
