John 3:16-17

16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

Agape love: The love of God for man. A love originating from God for mankind.

God did not want us separated from Him, so He sent His Son to bridge the separation.

It was God's love that compelled Him to give us the reason for Christmas.

Christmas is about God's love.

The Christian faith is based on God's love.

Isaiah 29:16

16 You turn things upside down,
as if the potter were thought to be like the clay!
Shall what is formed say to the one who formed it,
"You did not make me"?
Can the pot say to the potter,
"You know nothing"?

God's love is truth.

Truth wins.

Matthew 24:35

35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

John 17:14-17

14 I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. 15 My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. 17 Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.
