On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

John 17:14

14 I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. We have the ability to fight with divinely powered weapons.

We are called to take condemning words and thoughts to God instead of taking them to heart!

The key is to identify and believe.
