When we live "waiting for the other shoe to drop" we live in stagnation.

The 'shoe' is often our own accusing heart in disguise.

Jeremiah 17:9

⁹ The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?

Sarx, often translated as flesh; sarkikos which means carnal; and sarkinos, fleshy.

Our human ability to know, judge, or perceive good and evil.

Our human tendency to discern truth apart from God.

Our accusing heart causes us to live in dread.

Dread is worry accepted as truth.

We can't be in Christ and in our heads at the same time!

Our accusing heart is not the voice of God!
