<sup>8</sup> *But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you*

***When we live “waiting for the other shoe to drop” we live in stagnation.***

***The ‘shoe’ is often our own accusing heart in disguise.***

**Jeremiah 17:9**

<sup>9</sup> *The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?*

*Sarx, often translated as flesh; sarkikos which means carnal; and sarkinos, fleshy.*

*Our human ability to know, judge, or perceive good and evil.*

*Our human tendency to discern truth apart from God.*

***Our accusing heart causes us to live in dread.***

***Dread is worry accepted as truth.***

***We can’t be in Christ and in our heads at the same time!***

***Our accusing heart is not the voice of God!***
