That power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms

Jesus was synonymous with power.

1 Corinthians 1:24

²⁴ ...Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

John 14:12

¹² Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

The same power that dwelled in Jesus dwells in us.

2 Peter 1:3

³ His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.

We have the power to believe!

Our awareness has not aligned with the truth.

Awareness: What we know or perceive about a situation.

Is what I am perceiving really true?

Are we open to the idea that what we are perceiving may not be true?

If we aren't seeing our situation with power, we aren't being true to who we are in Christ!

Vantage point: position or standpoint from which something is viewed or considered

Our faith is determined by our vantage point.

How would our lives change if we saw all or our circumstances from the vantage point of power?

2 Timothy 1:7

⁷ For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

The way we ignite the power to believe is by defeating the enemy's lies!

Revelation 12:11

¹¹ They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony

What we speak becomes our vantage point.

What comes out of our mouths determines the way see our situation.

Psalm 27:1-6. 13-14

¹ The LORD is my light and my salvation whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—

of whom shall I be afraid?

² When the wicked advance against me to devour me,

it is my enemies and my foes who will stumble and fall.

³ Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear;

though war break out against me, even then I will be confident.

⁴ One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek:

⁶ Then my head will be exalted
above the enemies who surround me;
at his sacred tent I will sacrifice with shouts of joy;
I will sing and make music to the LORD.

¹³ I remain confident of this:

 I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

 ¹⁴ Wait for the LORD;

 be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.
