God does not struggle with unfinished business.

Philippians 1:6

⁶ being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Confident: Being sure of something; without doubt.

Isaiah 49:14-15

*¹⁴ But Zion said, "The LORD has forsaken me,
the Lord has forgotten me."*

*¹⁵ "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast
and have no compassion on the child she has borne?
Though she may forget,
I will not forget you!*

It would reflect on His character for God to forget us.

There is nothing more pressing to God than your healing and breakthrough.

Numbers 23:19

*¹⁹ God is not human, that he should lie,
not a human being, that he should change his mind.
Does he speak and then not act?
Does he promise and not fulfill?*

It's not about us – it's about God and His character!

Do you have a "Plan B" in place in case God doesn't come through?

If you are not sure and convinced of God's promises, you don't know God.

2 Timothy 1:12

¹² ...because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until that day.

John 15:16

¹⁶ You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last...

Philippians 2:13

¹³ for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.

God's work in us is never neutral – it is always for our good, and it is always worthwhile.

John 5:17

¹⁷ ...Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working."

Romans 8:28:

²⁸ And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

God will see the work He began in you through to completion.

There is no sense of arrival until the day we see Jesus face to face!

We all have the capacity and mandate to change, no matter our age!

1 John 3:2-3

² Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. ³ All who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure.

When Jesus Christ appears, we will instantaneously be like Him!
