### **Psalm 147:3**

*<sup>3</sup> He heals the brokenhearted  
and binds up their wounds.*

***God heals the broken and wounded places in our hearts, and closes the door so the enemy can't access it anymore.***

***Our hurts and brokenness often separate us from God.***

***God wants to restore us to wholeness and fellowship with Him.***

### **Genesis 1:27**

*<sup>27</sup> So God created mankind in his own image,  
in the image of God he created them;  
male and female he created them.*

### **1 John 4:9**

*<sup>9</sup> This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.*

### **Romans 5:8**

*<sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*

***God sent His Son to die for our sins so we could be with Him forever.***

### **John 3:16**

*<sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.*

***God made us in His image. Sin tarnished that image. Jesus purchased that image back.***

### **Matthew 28:20**

*<sup>20</sup> ...And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.*

***Jesus' purpose in us is not finished when we are forgiven.***

### **Luke 4:14-21**

<sup>14</sup> Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. <sup>15</sup> He was teaching in their synagogues, and everyone praised him.

<sup>16</sup> He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, <sup>17</sup> and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written:

<sup>18</sup> "The Spirit of the Lord is on me,  
because he has anointed me  
to proclaim good news to the poor.

He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners  
and recovery of sight for the blind,  
to set the oppressed free,

<sup>19</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

<sup>20</sup> Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him. <sup>21</sup> He began by saying to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

***Jesus came to give a pardon to the prisoners.***

***A pardon is an expression of forgiveness that eliminates the consequences of the conviction.***

### **Psalms 103:10**

<sup>10</sup> he does not treat us as our sins deserve  
or repay us according to our iniquities.

### **Galatians 5:1**

<sup>1</sup> It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

***To recover something is to regain possession of something that was stolen or lost.***

***God sent Jesus to restore and release something.***

***Jesus saves. But He also keeps on saving!***

*<sup>6</sup>being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.*
